September Service Change Trial

It's come to the place where we need to trial a different service times. This is not just because of my health concerns and the unsustainability of current services for a single priest, but also due to traffic changes, the health and wellbeing of many in the Parish and the need for us to live within the means of our resources and our size.

The trial will affect each centre in different ways but improve ministry for most, though not all, folk. We acknowledge that change is disruptive but is sometimes necessary and has occurred in the Parish at other times in response to need. The trial is in September, and as Council receives feedback and discusses the trial, we will assess continuing, adjusting or reverting to the old patterns.

AIREYS: No Sunday Service. Communion fortnightly 10:30am on a weekday.

ANGLESEA: Sunday Service moves to 9:00am. This means an hour Communion Service with morning tea afterwards. Those who are able to travel to Anglesea from Aireys will have Communion available on the alternate week.

TORQUAY: Sunday starts at 10:30am with morning tea at the front instead of the end of the service. The Communion Service will begin at 11:00am. The priest is then free to stay for morning tea at Anglesea, and arrive at Torquay between 10:30-11:00am without rush. Sharon will be available to chat on arrival at Torquay and will stay as she usually does until 12:15-12:30pm for anyone who wishes to chat afterward.

In addition at Torquay, the 1st Sunday will be a said Morning Prayer or Communion Service using the Prayer Book with no songs and no projector and a different service leader. This responds to our having no musician that week, it means once a month the priest can do other ministry at Aireys or Anglesea after the Anglesea Service, and no one needs to prepare the music and slideshow or operate the projector.

The Taize Service remains at 6:00pm. Wednesday Communion remains at 10:00am.
