**Sunday Services are now at Torquay and Anglesea**

**COVID updates** - No masks required the Diocese recommends wearing masks for those serving communion.

We have been reminded by the Diocese and DHHS that we are not to use books during services. This means we must always use the projector at Torquay and find a solution for this for Anglesea services.

Church services and the op shop are operating with the 2sqm rule where with QR codes. If you don't sign in with the QR code we need to do 4sqm.

Weddings and funerals can occur as previously under the same rules for church services.

100 visitors can be at a private home, inside or out, which relates to craft group and home group.

If you are unwell and showing symptoms of COVID, which are like symptoms of a cold, get tested and isolate while waiting for the results. Results are returned very quickly now, often in 24hours.

**St Luke's 75th Anniversary** - The anniversary of moving the current St Luke's church building to the Torquay site occurs on the first Sunday in August 2022, when regular services began after the building arrived in 1947. I would like to gather a group who will think, collaborate and plan how we will celebrate - either a few events across the year or one in August. The current building for St Aidan's held it's rededication in March and consecration in May 1986 and the current Transfiguration building had its first service in February 1957.

**New Op Shop Coordinator** - As Barry Butcher steps back from his role as an Op Shop Coordinator and remains a volunteer helping with the books, we will be celebrating his fantastic contribution to the shop in May sometime.

We are pleased to announce Roger Brown will take up the Coordinator role, resigning from his current Warden and council roles as of 1 June. Roger will be a great asset in the Shop as he is already well known to the team. Council are considering whether we wait to appoint a replacement at the APM in Oct/Nov or hold a special parish meeting to appoint someone sooner.

**Reconciliation Action Plan** - As part of our Acknowledgement of First Nations peoples as the Traditional Owners of the land on which we worship, the Diocese encourages us to have a reconciliation action plan. This helps us to genuinely work toward strong and respectful relationships with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people, to develop our understanding of the work of reconciliation and to commit to appropriate local action.
