Roger hopes to have a second quote shortly on the Ramp construction, the building industry situation has made it difficult for us to find a builder willing to commit a price or time to the project. Sharon is investigating some Parish Revitalisation organisations, Sharon and Rosalind will attend the Diocese 'Leading your church into growth' seminar in March. We will set up a Bunnings Trade Card, allowing us to purchase on account a larger range of items. Sharon is interacting with people and organisations outside the parish to build bridges and relationships, and was asked to increase her time interacting at Mainly Music.
