- Leading Your Church Into Growth Rosalind and Sharon attended this 3 day training in Melbourne. Our brains are full, so are our spirits. We were encouraged that we have already embarked on the journey despite the pandemic: taking serious consideration of our current situation, our hopes and fears about the future and we have made some ground addressing things. It may not feel like this, and it does not mean if we take the road forward with prayers, plans and action for growth that it will be without challenge. Council will get a summary of what we think is appropriate for us, and together consider about if and how we might move forward.
- Parish Council Finances steady. Highlights we have now transitioned to our new bookkeeper STS Accounting in Torquay; and January Op Shop sales \$16 053. We are beginning to work on the recommendations from the Parish Support Team's letter from Bishop Kate (though some of the recommendations are/have already being addressed). See noticeboards.
- Mulch a load of mulch is needed to finish off the area along the fence line behind the Op Shop. If anyone has a free voucher let Roger or John Bell know.
- **Parish Fete** 15th April. We received the permit for temporary signage; and can erect the signs 1st April. Ken updated the flyer and Facebook is updated. I have reached out to Surfcoast Times and the Geelong Addy to request free advertising. Check the notice in the narthex and write your name in a timeslot if you are able to help for some or all of the day, or the set up on the day before. All systems go! We are conscious of rising groceries costs, so if you need some or all expenses reimbursed, the parish is able to do this, just bring me a receipt.
