- Visiting Speaker Hospital Chaplain Rev'd Sheridan Hannah will lead and speak at both of our services on the 16th July. I will be in Anglesea at a prayer retreat in the Catholic centre, meeting with Jesus for myself and the parish. I have been talking to Sheridan about her ministry, and the disappearing funding for that important work. It will be good for us to hear about her work in Geelong's public hospital. Do make her welcome.
- **George Freijah's Memorial Service -** St Luke's 10:30am Thursday 13th July. Keep the family in your prayers.
- **Baptisms** Zachary and Eleanor Cullen will be baptised at St Luke's on Sat 15th July and Milana Ritchie at St Luke's on Sun 23th July.
- **Parish Council** We are waiting for our ramp plans to be updated, and submitted for approval and building. We are advised the whole roof at St Luke's will need replacing, we have leaks already and are seeking quotes. The Parish is taking over the registration costs of Mainly Music for our 2 centres. St Aidan's will be hired by St Kilda Community Baptist Church for a retreat in October. Plaques for the picnic tables at St Aidans are attached. Council will now meet at 2pm on the 4th Wednesday.
- **Pastoral Support Team Report** The PSTeam and Bishop noted the willingness of people to be involved and open in the conversations. Several items are being addressed: future of the parish is in discussion at LyCiG, in Reimagining the Future and other conversations. Further understanding of the needs of our congregations are needed but work is being done. There are differing expectations of the role of Vicar. There has been breakdown of communication between some members and the vicar and need for work on respectful dialogue and listening, as well as conflict management. Governance issues continue to need attention and understanding. Council discussed all the matters, noting an improved atmosphere but ongoing
