- **Chaplaincy** As you are aware Hospital Chaplaincy is having its funding cut which will result in a loss of this valuable service at University Hospital/ Barwon Health. The decision was made by Archbishop in Council as part of a comprehensive review of the budget. The Archdeacon and Area Dean made our regional concerns and dissatisfaction known to Bishop Brad and fellow Archdeacons and Area Deans in the recent episcopate meeting. Bp Brad has undertaken to communicate our shared concerns to the Archbishop and other Assistant Bishops. The fundraising campaign he initiated will continue.
- **Claritude Concert** Megan Waddington from St Luke's congregation is part of clarinet quartet and has offered to hold a fundraiser for the Parish on 17th September at 3pm. Adults \$15 children free.
- **Group Meditation Anglesea** after Wednesday the 9th Group Meditation will be in recess until further notice.
- Leading your Church into Growth (LyCiG) At our third meeting we shared our stories of faith with each other, to help us become more comfortable doing this with others. The next meeting is 7pm on 16/8 at St Luke's. Next meeting 16/8 at St Luke's 7pm. Other dates are under 'Regular Gatherings.'
- **Digital Support** We are joining a pilot program in the Diocese to investigate digital support for parishes. Sharon will be in conversation with Evan Englezos this week to see what this involves, hopefully it will help us find some ways to improve our processes across various parts of parish management and give us some support as well.
- **Op Shop Team Meeting and Changeover Date** The team has a volunteers meeting planned for 29th August for lunch prior to the seasonal stock changeover. A Half Price Sale follows this meeting on will be 20/23/24 September with a season stock changeover day on Monday 26th September.
