- **Group Meditation** Thanks to Linda Walter for guiding the group at Transfiguration again this year, and providing weekly material online. This has been appreciated by all who attend. If you'd like to attend, the group will meet for the last time pn 20th December and then gather again in the new year from the 7th February on Wednesday @ 11am.
- **First Sundays** just a reminder about the first Sundays of the month when Fr Irwin takes the St Luke's service and I stay in Anglesea. Besides the opportunities this provides for different ministry at each centre, we are running these as a 'low tech' service at St Luke's which means using books and orders of service, with no projector.
- Monday Communion on St Luke's Grass On Mondays between 11-11:30, from New Year's Day to Easter, a low key, simple communion will be held on St Luke's grass area to reach out in an informal way to people who are out and about. This is a collaboration with City On A Hill Surf Coast in response to God's leading. Dave Curnow is coordinating this with Rev'd Louis Glazebrook and myself. I will be involved on and off, and providing other support. We look to see what God will do, I encourage you to pray for meaningful interactions as the love of Jesus is shared during the holiday season.
- Hospital Chaplaincy 2024 at Synod 2023 funding for hospital chaplaincy came to an end, as a result of much consideration and a number of contributing factors. It has caused much concern across our whole Diocese and in our own region as the work is vital and has been in place for many years and more recently from Rev'd Sheridan Hannah, who shared with us about her work this year. Bishop Brad organised a fundraiser to extend the work at Barwon Health into 2024, funds have been raised for 1.5 days per week for a year. As good as this is, it is not enough to solve the problem.
