- Mothering Sunday The Simnel Cake that will be blessed during the service this morning has been made in memory of Helen Clement's much-loved grandmother Beatrice Stanhope. Beatrice was born in 1894 and attended Sunday School at St. Paul's, Bendigo. When Beatrice attended Sunday School it was the largest in Victoria with 1,300 children attending. She was confirmed at 16. Beatrice sang in the choir at St. Mark's Spotswood where she met George Stanhope. Following her marriage to George she became a GFS married helper at St. Mark's. She was a member of Ladies Guild and Mothers' Union for over 60 years. Mothering Sunday was a special day for Beatrice.
