- Social Responsibilities Committee ADOM 1. Environment Many Anglicans are committed to creation care but their work often takes place in isolation from people in other parishes. SRC is keen to connect people to share stories of their activities and encourage each other informally by Zoom. The first meeting will be in April, please contact SRC if you'd like to join.
- 2. Palm Sunday March for Refugees The format for the Palm Sunday Walk for Justice for Refugees is a bit different this year. It will be held in the morning of Sunday 24 March from 10am at Parliament Gardens. The Walk will begin at around 11:30am with a loop walk to Swanston Street and returning to Parliament Gardens. All are welcome to join at any stage of the event.

- 3. Workplace Ministry & Mission Synod 2023 passed an SRC motion that the diocesan vision and directions include strategy specifically for enabling, forming and supporting laypeople in their everyday workplace ministry and mission. Toward this end, a conference will be held in September for both clergy and laity as we together seek to understand the workplace experience in the light of Scripture and to shape this strategy.
- 4. **Disability** Synod 2023 also passed an SRC motion embracing the celebration of the UN International Day of People with Disability, on December 3rd. However, every day counts as a special day for those living with Disability
