- Fr Irwin Thanks Combined Service Irwin began as Assistant to Fr John Corby in 2001 and retired from this role under Rev'd Sophie Watkins in 2008. - CDS Container Deposit Scheme We are operational as an charity at the Container Refund Depots in the Western Region. If you have containers which are eligible look for the 10c refund mark choose us as your charity: search St Luke's Op Shop or Surfcoast Anglican Parish. Follow the instructions and when you are processing the containers hitting 'transfer' at the depot sends the money to us. We'll keep you posted on our income from this stream.
- Fete 2024 We raised around \$6627 for the fete (a correction from last week I doubled up on the eft for the shop). A spreadsheet is on the noticeboard with details. Well done team and thank you for your commitment and effort.

Council - We are beginning to draw pieces and ideas together for a strategic plan. John Shone, who has been a member of the parish for several years, working remotely and living in Indented Head, has been fellowshipping with us in person recently. He has provided advice on strategic development from his significant experience in community development work, so that we might draft a 'coastal' plan for our parish region. The plan includes input from parish members and other experts over the last 5 years, and with the wardens more recently. The initial draft will be discussed at Council on Tuesday. Following Council, Sharon meets with the Bishop on Wednesday for further advice and input, and to seek his support.
