Council - Parish council worked through a number of matters to smooth processes of approval for actions and payments. A new maintenance spreadsheet will help us track priorities, annual and approved/pending tasks. We will incorporate a budget/YTD/Annual sheet to help us see how much is still available on particular items as going forward. A brief proposed strategic plan was presented seeking prayer, thought, input and conversation from Council and the Bishop. We are investigating how we might find resources for extra workers, and simple strategies for increasing community life at each centre. A theme is 'Let us reimagine our Parish as reclaiming Village, Community, Family and Self through Mission as an act of Communion.' We had some clarifying conversations with the Bishop regarding funding can be used for, and contacts. We will begin to put some good things in play as soon as we can, including some extra hands for ministry, within our capacities and in the context of a larger plan that will enact in stages. We are finding out how we can do this.
