- **Strategic plan** After encouraging conversation with Parish Council and the Bishop, Sharon, Richard and John are continuing to clarify what an overall proposed plan might be for the Parish but actual details/ideas will continue to be discussed at Council. A theme is 'Let us reimagine our Parish as reclaiming Village, Community, Family and Self through Mission as an act of Communion.' It involves ideas of being a healthy small church with multiple expressions of life ('micro' church ideas), finding income for extra worker/s as soon as possible, and simple strategies for increasing community life and building on existing strengths at each centre now and into the future.
- We are looking at a staged approach, with fresh income coming in from short/ medium/long term income development, as well as what might usually be imagined as 'church' type ministry growth. We want to be a part of the town in each location and envision this includes Lorne. The parish would need to decide about Lorne at a parish meeting, advised by Council's conversations.
- Council will review a draft and look at obtaining a formal master plan to enable us to plan in a thought-out way, not add-hoc. It is very important to begin as soon as we can in sensible ways, mindful of finances but stepping out. A plan will help us work out which things we can finance ourselves, which need to wait, and which need grants or loans. There are Diocesan church planting funds we can apply for in the next 12 months, we must have a cohesive and approved plan to be successful and many parishes applying for the same \$\$. A plan enables us to pitch our case to the property committee and Archbishop in Council, and to speak with the Shire. We are in conversation with other church planting people in the Diocese to help us and listening to parish ideas.
- In addition we are in a cluster of parishes to pilot a project for funding towards further digital media and marketing enhancement to improve communication, functioning and events. It is the first strand of trying to
