- **Feed me Surfcoast** provided a gourmet lunch for the Op Shop Team meeting last week. We were grateful that they waived the cost of the food and were blessed by the quality of the spread we enjoyed. It's great when community groups work together.
- All Saints Lorne for several months, Fr Irwin has been providing services at Lorne. Some people in our parish have ongoing connection with All Saints and the Diocese has been providing supportive ministry for them for the last few years via Rev'd Phil Jacobson and clergy relief. As with our smaller centres, the town and church are significantly affected by the tourism vs residential challenge. The Anglican and Uniting churches have been working separately for a few years, but still have significant fellowship, and like Aireys Inlet and Anglesea have aging and small but faithful congregations.
- I encourage you to chat to Irwin about his ministry there, and to pray for them, in similar ways that we are praying for ourselves. The Prayer for Growth on the front page is a good place to start.
- **Building** we are in conversation with a builder about repairing the rotten external weatherboards around the Price St entrance at St Luke's. He will also give us a quote for replacing the ramp with steps at the Office door. The Hall Ramp is waiting for an updated plan to be approved by the Shire.
- **Parish Council Nov 22nd** As part of our future conversations Bp Brad will meet with Council for the November meeting at St Luke's.
